DRESS CODE

Definitions

- 1. In all cases below the rules refer to clothing worn by men.
- 2. Women shall in each case wear clothing of an acceptable standard.
- 3. In all cases the clothing shall maintain reasonable standards of presentability and decency.
- 4. "Neat Casual" shall include:
 - (a) Longs, shorts, smart denim jeans, open neck shirts with collars, smart shirts without collars, turtle neck and sweaters, t-shirts provided logos or names are discreet, bold slogans are not permitted.
 - (b) Closed sandals, training shoes without socks, and slops.
 - (c) No sweaty or dirty clothing.
- 5. "Golf Attire" shall not include:
 - (a) Draw-string pants, jeans, shirts without a collar, shoes without socks.

In the Clubhouse

The attire at all times will be "Neat Casual".

On the Course

(this includes the practice putting green, chipping area and practice tees)

The dress will be "Golf" attire.

The Club Manager and Committee Members shall have the right to address any person/persons for unacceptable attire.
